IDS MUST BE WORN

Tops/Blouses/Shirts

Only Black, Blue, Green, and Yellow (Gold) tops are permitted

Bandana is allowed

Mesh Tops, Spaghetti straps, Sleeveless blouses **are not permitted**

NO Midriff (bellyskin) blouses

Tops should not have any lewd, outrageous, inappropriate words or drawings.

Bottoms-Pants/Shirts

ONLY Black, Blue, Green and Yellow (Gold) bottoms are permitted.

NO Tight Fitting Jeans – No Jeggings, no ripped showing skin

Shorts and Capri **are not permitted**

NO Shorts or Tights allowed

Foot Wear

Closed slingback slippers sneakers or school shoes

Accessories

Hats/Caps are Allowed (Jamaican Colours or Manning's hat)

NO Jewellery (Jamaican Coloured Accessories are allowed)

NO Make Up
